LOAN AGREEMENT

The Guild's portable ring is available for use by Guild towers and branches with no charge, on the understanding that the borrowing tower or branch

- provides suitable transport for the ring to and from the location
- agrees to return the portable ring to the steward on or before the date agreed
- takes responsibility for routine maintenance of the ring during the agreed period
- ensures that the bells are kept in a locked place when unsupervised by a responsible person
- takes financial responsibility for any damage done, either to the bells and fittings, or to any individual person, during the agreed period
- passes all tower donations to the steward on returning the bells; a donation of £2 a rope for peals and 50p for quarters is expected
