- To offer opportunities for individuals, towers and branches to extend their ringing abilities, both in practical skills and in theoretical understanding

Maintaining contact with branches, towers and individuals

- To respond to other ad hoc requests for additional support
- To identify situations in which additional training input is possible, desired and helpful
