

INTER-TOWER 8-BELL STRIKING COMPETITION FOR NOVICES

Background information

The ethos of the 8 Bell Novice Competition is to encourage inexperienced ringers, who have not had the opportunity before, to be able to take their first steps into 8 bell competition ringing. These ringers maybe total newcomers to competition ringing or those who have experienced the 6 Bell Novice Competition and are now looking to further their experience to an 8 bell competition. The rules below have been designed to reflect this.

RULES

- 1. Each team will consist of at least one novice Ringing Member of the Guild who will ring a changing bell. A novice Ringing Member is one who has not rung a changing bell to a quarter peal on seven or more changing bells or previously rung a changing bell for the winning team of the competition. The remaining members of the team must be members of the Guild.
- 2. Each team may include up to three ringers who are also ringing for another team.
- 3. No ringer may ring the same bell for more than one team.
- 4. Teams wishing to enter will notify the Guild Secretary before the advertised date. The Guild Secretary will allocate the order of ringing.
- 5. Each team will be allowed a practice lasting no more than five minutes.
- 6. The treble will sound a warning to the judges. All ringing after this will be marked until the final bell has stood.
- 7. Each team will ring at one attempt a test piece of 168 changes of Plain Hunt Triples.
- 8. The judges will mark the striking of each test piece and award the trophy to the winning team. The decision of the judges is final.
